

**Status Report on Government of India Schemes  
under Implementation in Goa – Directorate of Health Services**

**A. Family Planning Compensation**

Sterilization services are held at hospitals and selected Health Centers on fixed days of the week. For the year 2017-18 (till November) 578 Tubectomy in female and 2 Vasectomy in males are conducted. All the clients are paid compensation as per Government of India under Scheme of compensation for the beneficiaries of sterilization. The payment is done at the facility performing sterilization operation. An expenditure of Rs.1.80 lakh has been incurred till November for implementation of the scheme.

**B. Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY):**

Ideally, the objective of the scheme is to promote Institutional deliveries which will contribute towards reduction of maternal and neonatal deaths. For the year 2017-18 (till November), 101 beneficiaries have availed of this benefit. An expenditure of Rs.0.70 lakh has been incurred till November for implementation of the scheme.

**C. Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakaram (JSSK) is a Government of India initiative:-**

This scheme is made available to all pregnant mother and sick infants.

**a) For pregnant Mothers:** Entitlements like free deliveries including caesarean section, free diet, free drugs & consumables, free diagnostics, free provision of blood are provided to all pregnant mothers. As regards free referral transport, it is provided either by CHC/PHC Ambulance or EMRI 108 Ambulances. For drop back home facility, 4 EMRI 108 Ambulances are placed (1 at DH each, 1 at GMC and 1 at SDH Ponda).

**b) Infants :** Sick neonates are entitled for free drug and consumables, free diagnostics, free blood transfusion and free referral transport.

**D. Goa State Illness Assistance Society: -**

The Goa State Illness Assistance Society provides financial assistance to the extent of Rs. 1.50 lakhs per patient below the poverty line for availing super specialty treatment which is not available in the State Government Hospitals. The Central Government shall contribute in the ratio of 2:1 of the contributions made by the State Government towards the fund, subject to a maximum of Rs. 2.00 crores.

This Scheme is meant for the persons living below the poverty line.

- (i) For Rural Families Income limit is upto Rs. 25,000/- per annum.
- (ii) For Urban Families Income limit is upto Rs. 60,000/- per annum

The Budget provision for the Goa State Illness Assistance Society is Rs. 60.00 lakhs for the current financial year 2017-18 under the Budget Head of Account: - 2210 – Medical & Public Health, 06 – Public Health, 101 – Prevention & Control of Diseases, 23 – Goa State Illness Assistance Society (P) (A), 31 – Grant- in- Aid. The expenditure incurred under the scheme up to December, 2017 is Rs. 6.76 lakhs as per this office record.

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
